**Glossary:**

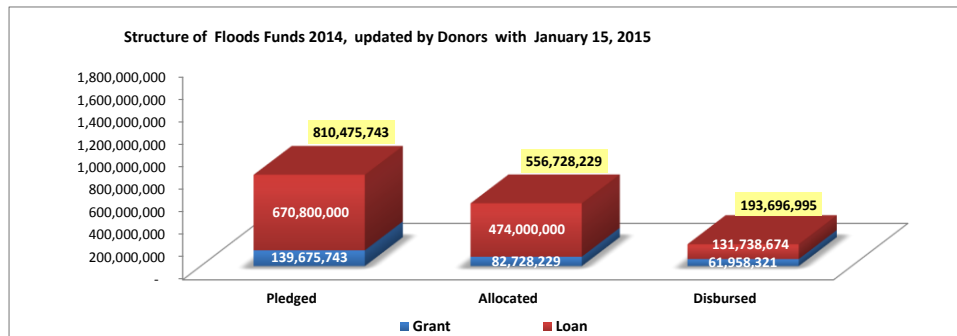
**Allocated Funds** – Allocated implies terms “Planned, Committed, Contracted”. For most types of financial flows, the face value of the activity at the date a grant or loan agreement is signed with the recipient, regardless of when disbursements are expected.

**Disbursed Funds** – The term “Disbursed” implies the terms “Paid, Spent”. A disbursement is the placement of Funds at the disposal of a recipient country or agency. It can take several years to disburse a commitment. Disbursement records the actual international transfer of financial Funds, or of goods or services valued at the cost of the donor. Disbursed Funds means entered actual amount of the released funds in the year when project/program is implemented.

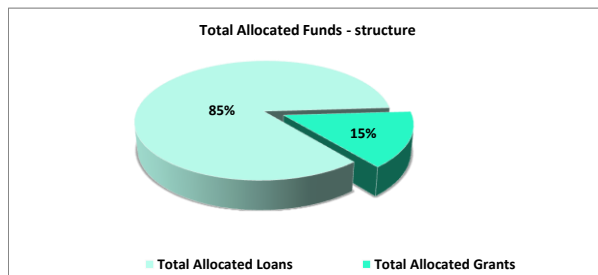

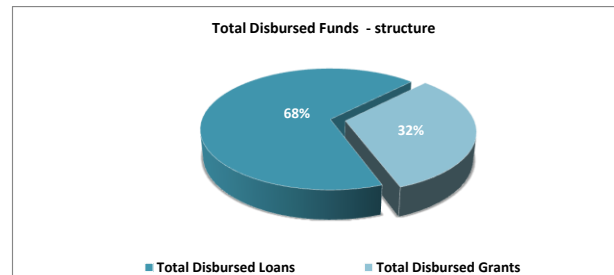
### Structure of Total Allocated Funds

### Structure of Total Disbursed Funds

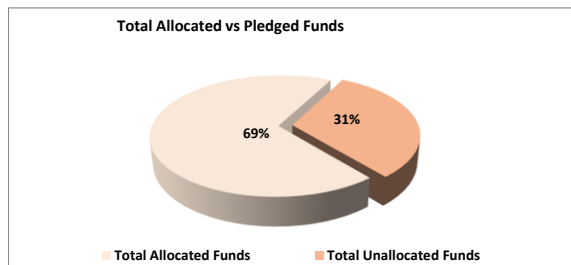

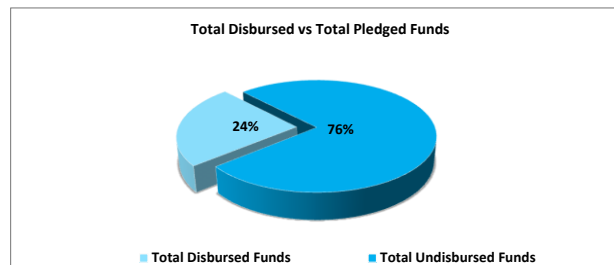
**Total Allocated vs Pledged Funds**

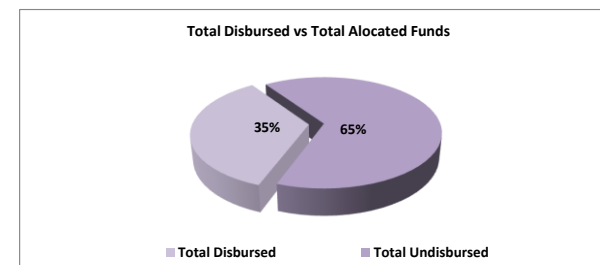
**Total Disbursed vs Total Pledged Funds**

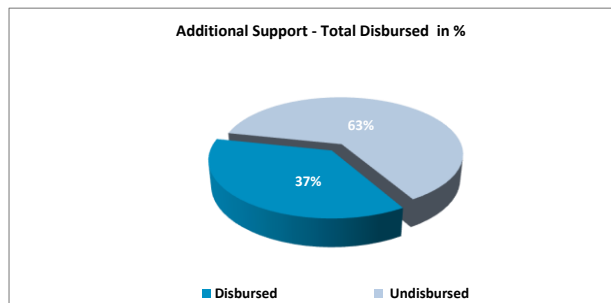
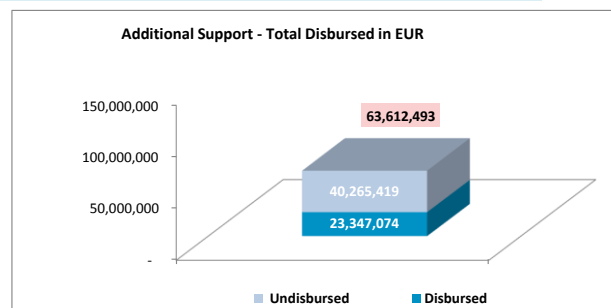
**Total Disbursed vs Total Allocated Funds**

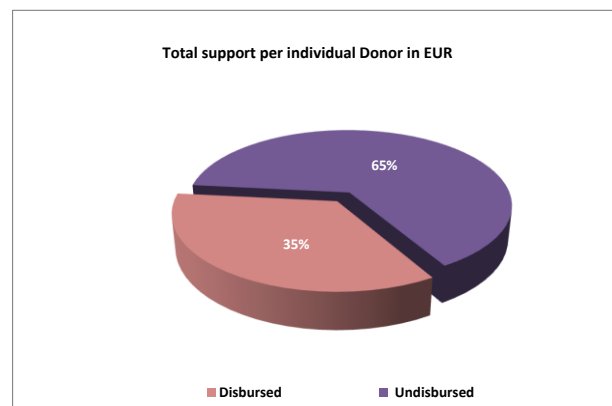
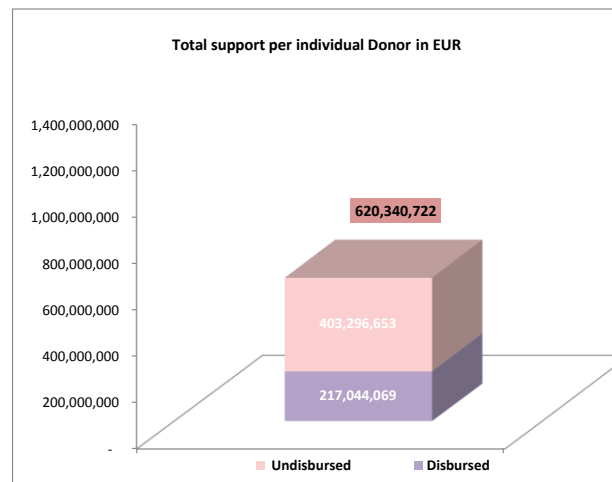
