


# The Government of the United Kingdom

## **Policy approach**


Programming in BiH since 2015 has been through the Western Balkans Conflict, Stability and Security Fund (CSSF) and the Good Governance Fund (GGF). The latter has focused on socio-economic reforms prioritised under the UK/German/EU-led Reform Agenda, while the CSSF programme (split between Stability, SOC, and Media/Cyber/Defence strands) has largely focused on democracy, reconciliation, gender-based violence (GBV) and Rule of Law (RoL) reform.

### Key activities in 2021

The Government of the United Kingdom € 6.46 million and disbursed € 5.47 million in 2021 in the form of grant to the following sectors: Education, employment and social policies, Democracy and governance, Rule of law and fundamental rights, Cross - cutting sector and Environment and climate action.







### Medium and long-term approach

The UK Government support will in the medium to long term look to meet the priorities and decisions of the Integrated Review and the UK International Development Strategy.

### **Development partners coordination efforts**

The UK attends a number of formal and informal meetings for coordination of developemnt partners, particularly those focused on the thematic areas mentioned above.
